

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) is intended to implement the programs as stated in the Memorandum of Understanding between Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU) Philippines and Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Ekonomi AAS Surakarta Indonesia. In particular, its purpose is to provide mutual opinion and agreement on "students' mobility and visiting professor program." Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU) Philippines acts as a host university and Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Ekonomi AAS Surakarta acts as home university.

Both Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU) Philippines and Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Ekonomi AAS Surakarta have come to an agreement to organize the following programs:

1. Students' Mobiliy.

- a. The home university will send students to host university.
- b. The host university will provide the followings for the program:
 - 1) Certificate
 - 2) Cultural Study/Tour
 - 3) Field study related to the disciplines (if necessaray).
 - 4) Letters of Acceptance (L.O.A) / Letter of Invitation
 - 5) Pick up service for the students to the airport and *excluding*:
 - 1) Meals
 - 2) Other personal expenses
- c. The host university will provide the dormitory for the students during the program.
- d. The minimum number of students is 2
- e. The courses selection to attend in the classroom for the students will be determined by both parties
- f. The host university will be in charge of all activities of the students from home university during conducting the program.

2. VISITING PROFESSOR Program.

- a. The home university will send teaching staff (lecturers) to host university.
- b. The host university will provide the followings for the program:
 - 1) Certificate
 - 2) Cultural Study/Tour (optional)
 - 3) Letters of Acceptance (L.O.A) / Letter of Invitation
 - 4) Pick up service for the lecturers to the airport
 - 5) Field study (if necessary) and excluding:
 - 1) Meals
 - 2) Other personal activities

- c. The minimum number of lecturers is 2.
- d. The courses selection to teach in the classroom for the lecturers will be determined by both parties
- e. The host university will be in charge of all activities of the lecturers from home university during conducting the program.


